Compared to other European countries, tuition fees in Italy are extremely low, especially in public Universities, where tuition fees range from €200 to €5200 per year, depending on family income.

Many Universities also offer scholarships to cover the tuition fees and sometimes also housing in the University campus and meals in the University cafeteria.

The cost of life in Italy depends on the city you live in: in northern cities, which are generally more expensive than southern ones, the average cost of living per month can be around €900, including accommodation.

HISTORICAL HERITAGE, LIFESTYLE AND SAFETY

Italy is the cradle of Western civilization: with 60 sites, Italy is the country with the most UNESCO world heritage sites. It is also home to the oldest University in the world, which was founded in Bologna in 1088!

Besides the excellent quality of education and the low tuition fees, you can complete your studies in a student-friendly environment thanks to the high quality of lifestyle, the great historical heritage, the food, the overall atmosphere and the welcoming people. Finally, millions of tourists choose to visit Italy every year for its safety: being one of the safest countries in the world, crime levels are generally really low and allow both tourists and residents to live comfortably in small towns and big cities alike.

Italy hosts some of the most ancient Universities in Europe and, at the same time, it is at the forefront of research and technology.



Italy, especially the northern part of Italy, offers plenty of opportunities to young people and international students in many different fields, from hospitality services to big technology companies to the fashion industry. Studying in Italy allows you to work up to 20 hours per week and grants you a 12-month period to look for a job after you completed your studies.

WHENAND HOW CAN I ENROLL IN AN ITALIAN UNIVERSITY





A general requirement that must be met to be eligible to apply to a Laurea (Bachelor's Degree) program is to have 12 years of schooling.

Requirements and procedures to enroll in an Italian University vary depending on whether you are an EU or a non-EU student, and whether you're applying at undergraduate (referred to as 'first cycle') or graduate level (second and third cycle).

Each University has a different admission procedure and its own admission test – details about the enrollment procedures can be found on the website of each University.

Qualifications obtained after 11 or 10 years of global schooling do not allow access to Italian Universities, unless you satisfy one of the following additional conditions:

- you attended one (in case of 11 years) or two (in case of 10 years) years of University studies;
- you obtained a post-secondary title to compensate for any missing years of secondary education;
- you attended a preparatory program (foundation year) at an Italian or foreign institution, to compensate for the missing years of schooling.

For students who have attended multiple secondary education institutions, secondary school qualifications will be considered valid if achieved after at least 2 years of attendance in the same education system.



DOCUMENTS NEEDED

TO APPLY TO AN ITALIAN UNIVERSITY, ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS:

A B C FINAL DIPLOMA OF SECONDARY STUDIES accompanied by a translation into the Italian language officially legalized by the Italian competent Consulate.

"DECLARATION OF VALUE" (DICHIARAZIONE DI VALORE), a document that certifies the validity of your diploma and that you are entitled to enter University.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE CERTIFICATE for programs held in Italian and **ENGLISH CERTIFICATE** for programs held in English. If you do not have a language certification, you will undergo a language test organized by the University.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE DOCUMENTS, NON-EU STUDENTS WILL ALSO NEED:



The entry VISA.



PRE-ENROLLMENT: the pre-enrollment application must be submitted through the Italian diplomatic or consular representation in your country usually from February to the end of July.



CERTIFICATE PROVING THE COMPLETION OF 1 OR 2 YEARS OF ACADEMIC STUDIES or a post-secondary title for those countries where the educational system lasts only 11 or 10 years, accompanied by its legalization or apostille.



CERTIFICATE attesting that the **UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE EXAMINATION IN THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN** has been passed if required by law (e.g. Gao Kao for Chinese students and Vestibular for Brazilian students).



Most of them date back to the 19th century and are among the most prestigious institutions in the world. Due to the excellent standards, admission procedures are highly selective and include practical assessments as well as oral interviews.

ITALIAN LANGUAGE COURSES

Our main language course is the intensive course, which consists of 20 classes per week (45 minutes each), for a total of three hours per day. The schedule can be from 9am to 12.15pm or from 2.15pm to 5.30pm, depending on the level and on the academic calendar. The course is available from 1 to 48 weeks.

The intensive course is one of the best ways to learn Italian fast and efficiently: our communicative approach, which means more opportunities for you to speak Italian during classes, allows you to complete a level in around 6 weeks. We will help you to develop all four linguistic abilities (listening and reading comprehension, writing and oral expression) and provide you with a strong grammatical basis.

CILS EXAMS

Scuola Leonardo da Vinci is officially recognized by the Siena University for foreigners as an examination center for the CILS exams, the most prestigious and internationally recognized certificate that attests the linguistic-communicative competence in Italian as a second language.

Most Universities require an upper-intermediate level (B2) in order to access their Italian programs. Some of them also accept students with a B1 level provided that students bridge the linguistic gaps before the first exam session in January.

Students will be able to sit their exam twice a year in the comfort of the school and will, of course, receive all the assistance necessary from the school staff. Scuola Leonardo da Vinci also offers level tailored preparation courses with highly specialized teachers to learn how to tackle the exam in the most efficient way.

All didactic materials (books, handouts etc.) are included in the registration fee. As for other specific supplies, students are strongly recommended to bring their own personal equipment.


CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE

VISA

The procedure for the student visa application is the following:

- 1. You should fill our online application form on our website <u>scuolaleonardo.com</u>
- Once we receive the application, we will send you an e-mail with all the details about the course and payment methods: we should receive the payment of the global tuition fee in order to issue the certificate of enrollment.
- 3. To prepare the certificate, we are going to need the following documents:
- copy of passport
- information about your previous studies (Italian language level and name of the University/post diploma course you attended)
- · address where you will live in Italy
- 4. Once we receive the payment for the course and all the documents mentioned above, we will prepare the certificate and send it by e-mail.
- 5. Besides our certificate, to apply for the visa you will also need the following documents:
- proof of accommodation
- bank statement
- · health insurance
- · motivation letter (not mandatory, but highly recommended)
